JOB DESCRIPTION

Purpose: Produce, mount and ship photopolymer plates to meet production schedule and customer demands.

Reports to: Facility Leader

Status: Non-exempt (Hourly)

Essential Responsibilities:

- 1. Produce photopolymer plates to meet production schedule and customer ship dates while maintaining the highest quality standards. Utilize micrometer to ensure plates are within plate tolerance. Cross-check file with proof for digital plates; double-check quality of films for analog plates.
- 2. Make and/or adhere plate backing as needed, mount and proof plates, clean and seal plates per specifications. Prepare and inspect mounted plates prior to shipment.
- 3. Prepare and expedite shipments per work ticket instructions and/or customer specifications, including but not limited to: create and affix proper labeling, assemble and pack appropriately to prevent damage in transit, prepare and complete required recordkeeping for incoming and outgoing shipments in a timely and accurate manner, calculate weight, shipping charges and postage. Perform quality assurance check of products prior to packaging and shipment.
- 4. Follow all pertinent safety, quality, and environmental standards, work instructions, and OEC standard operating procedures.
- 5. Accurately record job billing of time and materials utilized to produce products.
- 6. Provide accurate inventory counts and reorder items as needed or directed.
- 7. Maintain safe, clean, and neat work areas. Perform equipment maintenance as needed or as instructed.
- 8. Other duties as assigned or required for efficient operations.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Basic math aptitude; individual must know basic math skills and be able to read a ruler
- Ability to manage numerous projects simultaneously
- Demonstrates independent judgment
- Able to safety operate a forklift
- High level of accuracy and attention to detail
